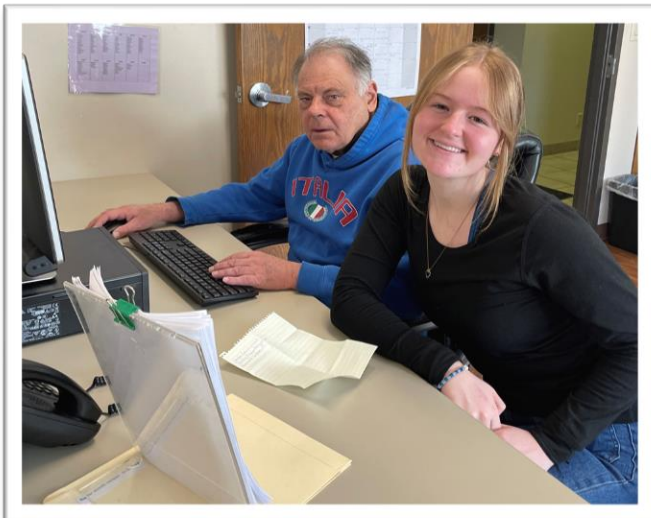
Hunter E.

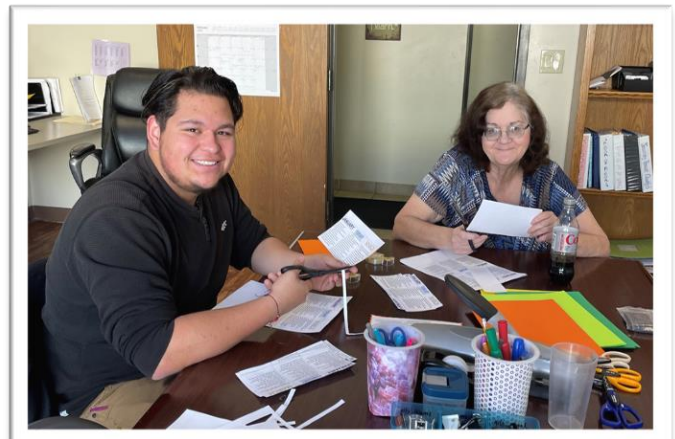
Mary Jane U.

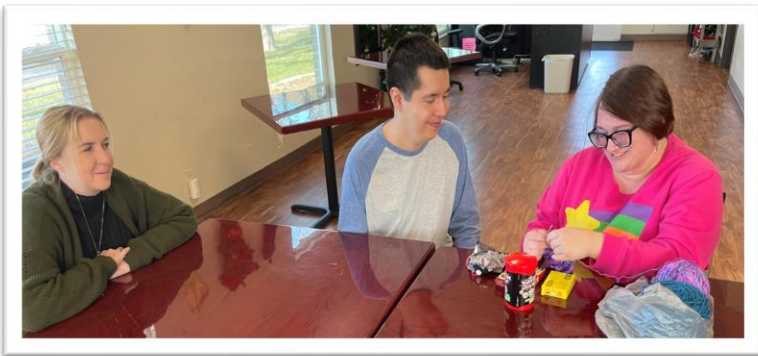

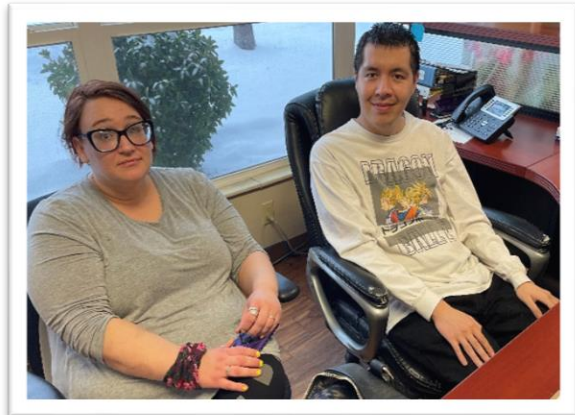

Employment & Education Dinner with Marianne

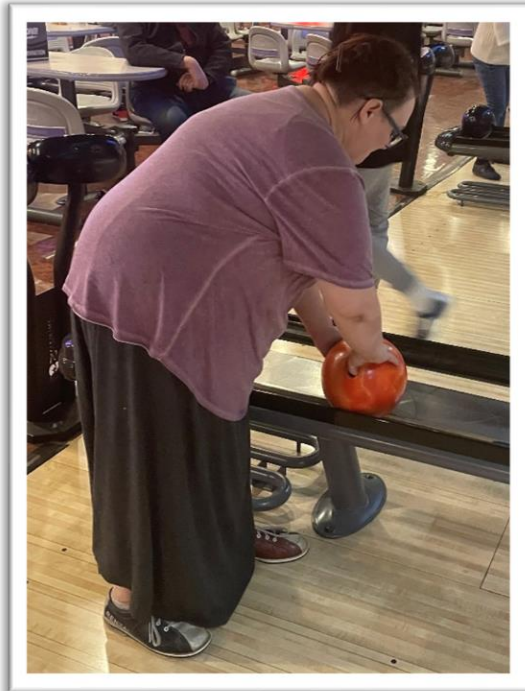
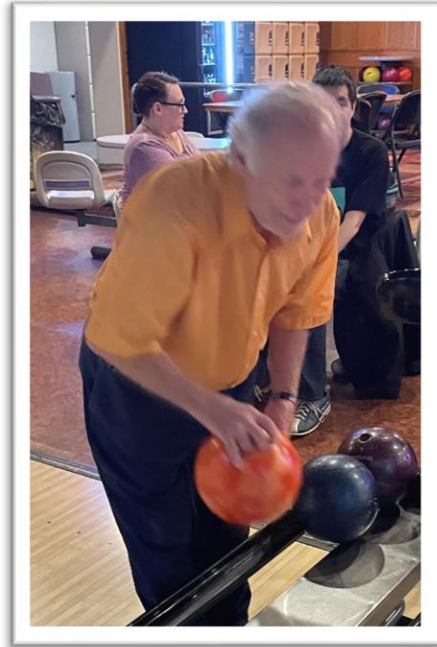

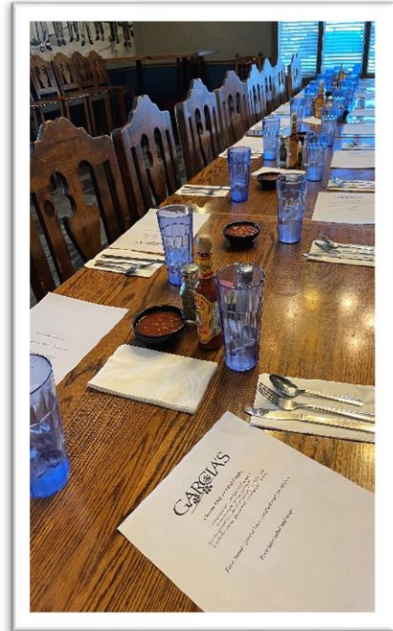
